Project includes construction of one-way loop road from Seaport Boulevard for commercial trucks, weigh station, loading facilities, and office (Figure 1).

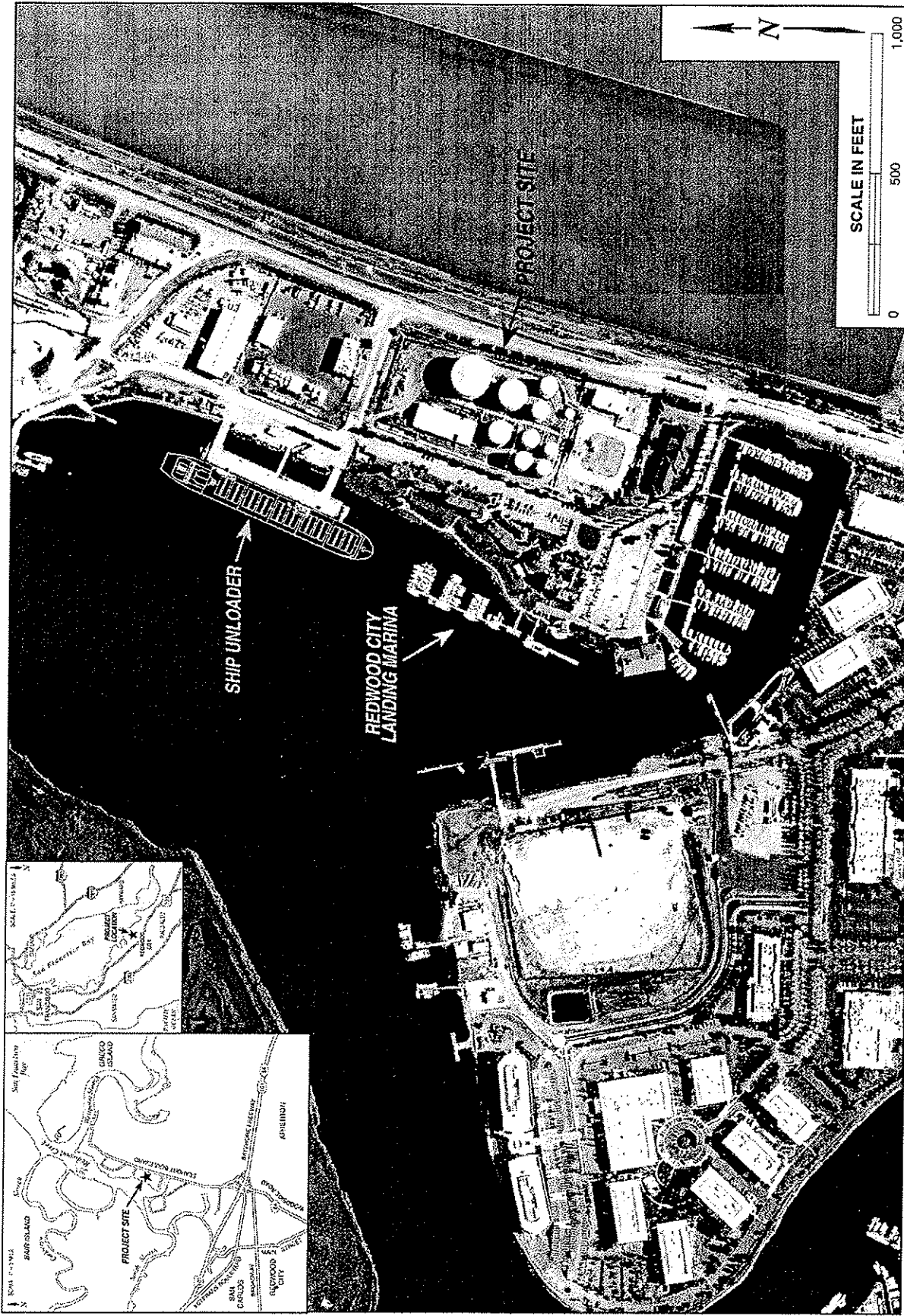
