



Fireworks FAOS

The 2017 4th of July fireworks will be launched from the Port of Redwood City! This wonderful show is brought to the community with *sponsorship support from Sares Regis, Sims Metal Management, County Consumer Plumbing Service & Repair Group, Recology, Boardwalk Chevrolet, The Port of Redwood City and The City of Redwood City..*

- Live music will begin at 7:00pm.
- There will be food trucks on hand from 7-9pm.
- The fireworks extravaganza will start at approximately 9:30pm.
- The fireworks can be seen from areas where there is a clear view of the skies above the Port, and can also be seen from high points all over the Peninsula.
- For those coming to the Port, early arrival is highly recommended! This area is mostly private property with very limited public parking.
- The Port is providing a public viewing area along the waterfront off of Seaport Court. Once all of the very limited public parking spaces are filled, Seaport Boulevard will be closed to all vehicle traffic at the intersection of Seaport/Blomquist. **Once the intersection has been closed, no vehicle access to the Port area will be available. This traffic control restriction could occur as early as 7:30 pm – so be sure to plan accordingly.**
- Alcohol is *prohibited* on-site at the fireworks show, and **personal fireworks are illegal at all times in Redwood City.**
- There will be portable restrooms and sinks on site
- No BBQs
- Please do not bring your pets. Pets, particularly dogs, have very sensitive ears and the booms and bangs associated with a fireworks display can be quite uncomfortable. Leave pets at home if you are planning to attend a fireworks show. Also leave a radio or TV on at home to help keep your pets calm in case illegal fireworks are used in your neighborhood.
- Be sure to bring a blanket!
