NOTICE TO RECREATIONAL BOATERS

U.S Army Corps of Engineers Channel Maintenance Dredging beginning in the Inner Turning Basin adjacent to the Port's Wharf 5 and ending at the Channel Entrance to S.F. Bay

- Dredging operations are expected to begin August 7, 2017 and will be completed by November 2, 2017
- Dredging will occur 24/7 until project completion

Boaters should watch out for the following equipment and vessels that will be involved in the projects:

- Dredge Barges and Dump Scows
- Survey and Crew Boats

Recreational boaters should consider the following

- Using VHF radio to alert dredge of recreational boaters intentions using channels 13, 14, and 80.
- Be visible and attach lights for dredge/tugs/survey boats to see recreational boaters during nighttime hours.
- Dredge will use spud piles instead of anchor buoys.
- Stay a safe distance of at least 100 feet from dredge or scows.
- Please be advised that when a tug is pushing the dredge or scows, they stop very slowly. Do not overtake the dredge or scows too closely when they are moving.
- Avoid the middle of the channel used by contractor equipment and use outside edges of channel.
