**NOTICE TO RECREATIONAL BOATERS**

**U.S Army Corps of Engineers Channel Maintenance Dredging**  
**Beginning in the Inner Turning Basin adjacent to the Port's Wharf 5 and**  
**Ending at the Channel Entrance to S.F. Bay**

- Dredging operations are expected to commence on or after 6 DECEMBER 2023.
- Dredging will occur 24/7 until project completion, tentatively mid-late MAY 2024.

**Boaters should watch out for the following equipment**  
**and vessels that will be involved in the project:**

- Tugs, Dredge Barges and Dump Scows
- Survey and Crew Boats
- White mooring Buoys with blue stripe topped with white lights

**Recreational boaters should consider the following:**

- The dredge will be working VHF radio channel CH 11 and monitoring 13 and 14 for communication of recreational boaters' intentions.
- Be Visible and attach lights for dredge/tugs/survey boats to see recreational boaters during nighttime hours.
- Keep adequate distance from dredge to avoid the swinging bucket and moving equipment. Do not go alongside the dredge.
- Keep 500ft distance from the tugs, scows, & dredge while scows are being swapped out at the dredge. Never go between the scow and dredge.
