

## **WATERFRONT USER SAFETY GUIDELINES**

## RECREATIONAL BOATERS USING REDWOOD CITY NAVIGATION CHANNEL

- 1. Keep to the outer perimeter of the Channel, avoid the center of the Channel.
- 2. Yield and give right of way to ferries and vessels.
- 3. Maintain high visibility with bright colored apparel and lights at nighttime.
- 4. Federal regulations require boaters to maintain a distance of at least 150 feet when ships are berthed at the Port wharves 1 -5

## FERRIES USING REDWOOD CITY NAVIGATION CHANNEL

- 1. Keep to the center of the Channel, avoid the outer perimeter of the Channel.
- 2. Upon encountering recreational boaters, provide additional distance when slowing down and resuming speed.
- 3. If multiple recreational boating groups are ahead, maintain slower speed to the dock entering the Port area or until clear of all groups when leaving the Port area.
- 4. Federal regulations require boaters to maintain a distance of at least 150 feet when ships are berthed at the Port wharves 1 -5
